How to become a Catholic: In the Autumn, there will be a Journey in Faith Programme (RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) for our Family of Parishes (Leyland, Farington, Penwortham, Longton, and Tarleton). It will run from November through to the Holy Week and Easter Services next April when those who wish to become Catholics will do so at the Easter Vigil in their own parish. Therefore, from September all current names will be removed from the sick list. If you want a name included on the sick list, please fill in a "Sick List" form and include the person's name, contact details, and their consent. Normally, only names of people who are seriously ill, awaiting surgery, or housebound will be included. After six weeks the name will be removed, but you can add them again.
