Jack Traynor miracle declared: Please read the attached statement from the Archbishop. Jack was a pilgrim on the Archdiocese's first official pilgrimage to Lourdes in 1923 and was cured dramatically of epilepsy, paralysis of the right arm and paraplegia during the pilgrimage. This is the 71st officially recognised miracle in Lourdes since Our Lady's apparitions to St Bernadette in 1858.

<u>Change of parish boundaries</u>: After due consultation, the Archbishop has decreed that: "Buckshaw Village is transferred into the territory of St Catherine Labouré at Farington, and Farington Moss is transferred into the territory of St Mary at Leyland from 8th December 2024". The catchment areas of the parish schools are not changed.

<u>Christmas Day Collection</u>: In keeping with Archdiocesan practice, the collections on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day are paid into the parish bank account to cover usual parish expenses.

<u>New Altar Servers</u>: A group of adults and children have been trained to be altar servers. They will be officially welcomed during 11.00 am Mass on the Feast of St Stephen, 26th December.
