

On Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February, the brand-new Nursery building of St Mary Magdalen's School in Penwortham was blessed and opened by Archbishop Malcolm McMahon accompanied by Fr Ian McParland (Parish Priest) and David Shaw (Mayor of Penwortham) alongside children, staff, governors and guests. It has been 18 months in the planning for the Mighty Minis but now welcomes 15 children daily 3 years+. The Nursery was first opened in February 2022 and proved to be so popular that it had to move into the Church Hall after only a few months. School Leaders and Governors sought funding, and the Archdiocese of Liverpool committed £160,000 to the new build. Father Ian McParland and the parishioners generously donated land at the back of the church building, adjacent to the school, and the project was developed.

The Archbishop was welcomed with a rousing rendition of the School's adopted hymn 'All are Welcome' which sows the seeds for the local community who are all very welcome in the school.

#### Journey In Faith (RCIA) Group – Family of Parishes

Our Journey In Faith (RCIA) group meeting at St Teresa's Penwortham, continues to be a blessing to all involved – both for the 'Enquirers' – those considering becoming Catholics within our family of parishes and our team of helpers.

We have recently completed five sessions on the sacraments focusing especially on the three sacraments of initiation; Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Upon receiving these sacraments at Easter, the members of our group will be fully received into the life of the Church.

We are now moving on to explore the riches of the Spiritual life of the Church including Ways of Praying, the special place of Mary, and the social teaching of the Church.

With different speakers every week and opportunities to ask questions and share in small groups our times together each Wednesday have been vibrant, friendly and thought provoking.

We always finish with a time of prayer arranged by the lay people of our parishes and offering the group time for reflection and an encounter with Our Lord, who is at the heart of everything we do.

Please pray for our Enquirers and their families as they prepare to take a major step in their faith journey as we move through Lent and towards the great Easter Vigil service.
