

All parishioners are invited to attend, and this year our altar servers have been especially invited to join in the procession with servers from across the whole Archdiocese. <u>Pastoral Letter on Assisted Suicide Legislation:</u> We will listen to a message from the Archbishop this weekend. The important vote for all MPs on the assisted suicide legislation, known as the *Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill*, is likely to take place on 25th April. The charity **Right to Life UK** has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their Member of Parliament and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law.

<u>Palm Crosses:</u> This year's palm crosses will come from The African Palms Association in Tanzania (<u>www.africanpalms.co.uk</u>). The project's aim is to give local villagers in the Masasi area of Tanzania a chance to earn extra money. The palm crosses are made from the dried branches of the dwarf palm Hyphae Coriacia which grow wild in the area and so are not cultivated or chemically treated.
